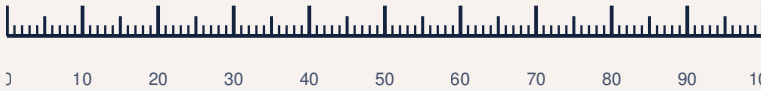


Print-at-Home Ring Sizer

A precise finger gauge you cut out and wrap around your finger. Accurate only when printed at **100% / Actual Size**.

STEP 1 — PRINT AT 100%, THEN VERIFY

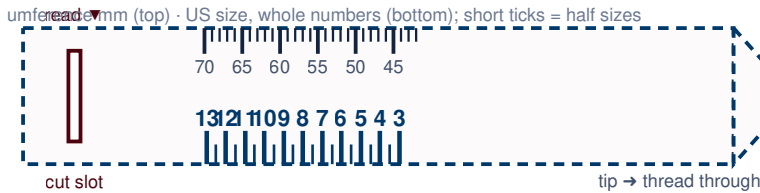
In your print dialog set **Scale: 100%** (or "Actual size") — **NOT** "Fit to page" / "Shrink to fit". Then measure the ruler below with any ruler: the line must be exactly **100 mm (10 cm)**. If it isn't, adjust scale and reprint.



No ruler handy? A standard credit/ID card is **85.6 mm** wide — line its left edge up with the left mark; the right edge should hit the right mark exactly:



STEP 2 — CUT & MEASURE



1. Cut out the strip along the dashed outline, and cut the small slot.
2. Wrap it around the base of your finger (or an existing ring), scale facing out.
3. Thread the pointed tip through the slot and pull snug — comfortable, not tight.
4. Read the number at the slot edge: **bold = your US size**; small = circumference in mm.
5. Measure warm, at day's end. If between sizes, choose the larger. Wide bands run larger.
